GT Commercial Update Instructions Pre-2012 Online Capable

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ

This update is for games that have 2012-year courses and older versions. The software version will be 7.02.XX or a lower major number. This update requires a **Hard Drive change** and a **System RAM** change. The hard drive must be physically changed to complete the update to version 16.04.XX GT LIVE 2021.

The system box will need to be removed from the cabinet in order to replace the hard drive and system RAM stick. The completed update will be compatible with 16:9 aspect ratio HDTVs Only.

- Golden Tee Cabinet Marquee

• 1 GB DDR2 SYSTEM RAM

This update procedure consists of 2 Sections.

- Section 1: Removing the system box to replace the system RAM and hard drive.
- Section 2: Replacing the U101 Security chip on the IO board

Tools/equipment required for Memory Upgrade:

- ¹/₄-inch Hex Nut Driver (no longer than 9 inches)
- Standard/Flat Head Screwdriver
- Good lighting

Section 2 - Security Chip Replacement

- 1. Turn OFF all power to the game.
- 2. Carefully remove the socketed security chip found at U101 on the I/O Board. (A small flat blade screwdriver works best.) It is extremely important to note the orientation of the chip. The small black dot (Pin 1) must be on the same side as the USB Port.
- 3. Make sure the new chip is oriented the same as the old chip before inserting it into the U101 socket. Be sure the chip is seated properly with no bent pins.
- 4. Turn on Power to the game. Your game will power up to the new version.

Note: If the Security Chip is damaged, DO NOT THROW IT AWAY. It is required when purchasing a replacement.

Showpiece Marquee Installation



- 1. Slide the rectangular marquee mounting frame from its position on the two upright posts.
- 2. Remove any one of the four side pieces of the mounting frame.
- 3. Remove the current plastic laminate marquee from the mounting frame, but do not remove the cardboard.
- 4. Slide the updated marquee into place and reassemble the side piece or pieces. Make sure all of the surrounding pieces of the mounting frame are tight and the plastic laminate is smooth against the cardboard.
- 5. Slide the fully assembled marquee back into position.

Note: No cutting required when installing the Showpiece marquee.

System Box Filter Cleaning

A clean filter is very important for proper cooling and optimal performance of the hardware. Be sure to clean this filter regularly.

- 1. With the back door removed, slide out the ventilation filter located on the underside of the system box.
- 2. Clean the filter thoroughly so it is free of dust and debris.
- 3. Insert the filter back into the slots of the bracket located on the underside of the system box.
